### ESTATE PLANNING DOCUMENTS FOR THE COLLEGE BOUND KIDS

As most kids get started in college this week make sure yours packs all the necessary medical documents. A college student should have the following items (particularly is he/she is considered a legal adult in Illinois and/or the state where his/her college is located):

#### Health Care Power of Attorney

With a health care power of attorney, your child appoints someone as his/her proxy or surrogate for health care decisions. Typically, the parents are designated as agents to make decisions regarding your child's health care if he/she cannot make them on his/her own (e.g., coma, unconsciousness, etc.)

#### HIPAA Authorization

To accompany the health care power of attorney, a Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act authorization gives health care providers the ability to share information about your child's medical condition with you and your spouse. Absent a HIPAA authorization, making health care decisions could be more difficult.

These two documents would give you, as parent, the peace of mind that you need when your child is away from home.

#### DACA UPDATE

Last week, in the latest ruling on Texas v United States, Judge Hanen issued an opinion denying the plaintiff states' request to provide preliminary injunctive relief. This means that **for now**, *DACA recipients will continue to be able to renew their work permits*. The Perrom Law Office, LLC encourages DACA recipients to renew their DACA status/work permits immediately in order to guarantee their ability to legally work for as long as possible.
